

## Narrative discussion of assessment:

Basically, the Do activities which will be combined with the Absorb Activities will mostly include a Discussion Item or two each week. A rubric on the Discussion Posts has been attached in the website under the Activities and Assessments Tab. The feedback will be given to the participants each week as soon as the participants meet the discussion posting requirements or to maximize participation, if not so active, within 24 hours after the weekly session has ended.

The only sample Connect activity with rubric prepared is the teaching philosophy and rubric is posted as file attachments in the Activities and Assessments tab. The feedback will be given to the participation within 48 hours after posting or submission.
